Yes (10 c = 1 dime)

A sticker costs 15¢. Liam has 2 nickels and 1 dime. Can he buy it?

Yes (20 c > 15 c)

A ball costs 25¢. Mia has 1 quarter. Can she buy it?

Yes (25 = 1 quarter)

A toy car costs 30¢. Ethan has 3 dimes. Can he buy it?

Yes (30 c) = 3 dimes

An eraser costs 5¢. Emma has 1 nickel. Can she buy it?

Yes (5 = 1 nickel)
