

Word problems counting with coins



1st grade: Math

Everyday Items

A cookie costs 10¢. Olivia has 1 dime. Can she buy it?

A sticker costs 15¢. Liam has 2 nickels and 1 dime.
Can he buy it?

A ball costs 25¢. Mia has 1 quarter. Can she buy it?

A toy car costs 30¢. Ethan has 3 dimes. Can he buy it?

An eraser costs 5¢. Emma has 1 nickel. Can she buy it?



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Everyday Items

A cookie costs 10¢. Olivia has 1 dime. Can she buy it?

Yes (10¢ = 1 dime)

A sticker costs 15¢. Liam has 2 nickels and 1 dime.
Can he buy it?

Yes (20¢ > 15¢)

A ball costs 25¢. Mia has 1 quarter. Can she buy it?

Yes (25¢ = 1 quarter)

A toy car costs 30¢. Ethan has 3 dimes. Can he buy it?

Yes (30¢ = 3 dimes)

An eraser costs 5¢. Emma has 1 nickel. Can she buy it?

Yes (5¢ = 1 nickel)
